



Registering to Vote When You Don't Have a Driver's License or State ID

Step 1:

Print Out and Complete “State of Georgia Application For Voter Registration”, [See This Link](#)

Step 2:

Using the United States Post Office, immediately **physically mail** Form in a stamped-envelop to the Secretary of State, State of Georgia, PO Box 105325, Atlanta, GA 30348-9562.

In addition to completing the Form you need to [include in the mailing envelop a document evidencing “Proof of Residency”](#). For a high school student provide one of the following:

- **[Bank Statement](#)** that shows Your Address
- **[Paycheck](#)** that shows Your Address
- Obtain **[Voter ID](#)** from the following two choices below. **You must bring:** Birth Certificate, Social Security Card, Bank Statement showing your address, or Passport.
 - ✓ **Any Department of Driver's Services** (where you get a driver's license). Google locations at “Georgia Department of Driver's Services” **OR**
 - ✓ Your respective County Elections Locations for which there is only one per county.

Step 3: As Desired
