

Registering to Vote When You Don't Have a Driver's License or State ID

Step 1:

Print Out and Complete "State of Georgia Application For Voter Registration", See This Link

Step 2:

Using the United States Post Office, immediately **physically mail** Form in a stamped-envelop to the Secretary of State, State of Georgia, PO Box 105325, Atlanta, GA 30348-9562.

In addition to completing the Form you need to <u>include in the mailing</u> <u>envelop a document evidencing</u> "<u>Proof of Residency</u>". For a high school student provide one of the following:

- Bank Statement that shows Your Address
- <u>Paycheck</u> that shows Your Address
- Obtain <u>Voter ID</u> from the following two choices below. You must bring: Birth Certificate, Social Security Card, Bank Statement showing your address, or Passport.
 - ✓ Any Department of Driver's Services (where you get a driver's license). Google locations at "Georgia Department of Driver's Services" OR
 - ✓ Your respective County Elections Locations for which there is only one per county.

Step 3: As Desired
